

"This is a big, bold, sassy musical with great songs, big set pieces and is genuinely funny "








Online Ticket Booking: new feature, Add to Calendar

We've had a number of audience members turning up to see a pre-booked performance on the wrong day! So every bit of help we can get remembering pre-booked events is important these days with everyone's busy schedules.

Electrical Problems at Hackett Hall

Earlier this year Nedlands Council informed Playlovers that electrical work was required to bring the hall up to regulation standard. Tony Ridout engaged an electrical contractor, and, between them, they planned to do it all in the school holidays when the hall was relatively free from other users.

Unfortunately, when the work began, they discovered that due to years of neglect by the council, the electrical infrastructure was a mess.

In summary, required RCD's (Residual Current Devices) were installed and when switched on, immediately tripped and were unable to relatch - as **should** happen when a power leakage is detected. As a result, there have been no lights for a couple of weeks. A search for the fault found aged wiring, faulty fluorescent lights and a multitude of other problems.

Over the weekend of 19-20 Oct, Wally Fry, with several other non-technical committee members, assisted with the installation of equipment, and John Woolrych installed interim lighting measures.

Work will resume Monday 27th and it is expected that all major issues will be resolved then and schedules set for the tidying up of minor issues. Our thanks also to the contractor, Ian Ashton, who has pulled out all the stops to keep the cost down.
