
GRADS Aladdin and his Wonderful Lamp

Air conditioning was installed in the auditorium, the foyer and Green Room have been spruced up with new carpets and freshly painted walls and we have securely enclosed the box office.

Next on the agenda is the bar area. We have unfortunately been told our facilities need to be brought in line with the new health regulations and while we address these issues, it is regrettable that we will have to use polystyrene cups for tea and coffee and plastic glasses for wine.

Additionally, food preparation will need to be done in the kitchen adjacent to the stage and this will have ramifications for the high tea on 16th November. We will need to use large platters to minimise the transfer time, so we apologise in advance for any inconvenience, and if it doesn't look quite the same.
