Small Poppies is a play about the first year of school, set in Australia during the 1980s. While it has some very moving scenes it is also very funny. It is a beautifully crafted play, which entertains 5 yr olds to 90 yr olds.

It is an ensemble piece with each actor playing a range of characters.

Adult actors play the year one students. The script calls for a minimum of 6 actors – 3 females and 3 males.

I may increase the cast depending on the auditions. Age and ethnic background are not important.

I am looking for strong actors aged from 20 years up who are prepared to play a variety of different roles, extend themselves, take a risk and work as a team. Some parts require an accent (Greek and Cambodian) and some the ability to hold a tune like a yr1 student.

I have wanted to direct this play for a long time and I am so looking forward to casting and getting on with it.



Robbie is a very special person and it was concurred by all at the committee from the first nomination by John Woolrych.







## In the Shade of the Pear Tree

'A hauntingly beautiful conversation between two women as they bridge time and culture.'

Conscripted at 16. Refugee at 17. Bride at 20. Mother at 21. How can Amelia relate to her Macedonian grandmother?
