



I Hate Hamlet is an American comedy about a young good-looking TV soapie star who decides he would like to have a go at the classics, in this case, Shakespeare.

He has been offered the role of Hamlet in a Central Park Production of - you guessed it - *Hamlet*. This entails him having to move from LA to New York and to acquire an apartment which turns out to be a very interesting place.

However, doubts in his ability to play the classics begin to arise and he desperately needs assistance!! How does Andrew Rally go about getting help?

When asked what happens to the leading man, Hough Neilson replies "Well, why don't you come along and find out? I promise you will not be disappointed. This is a great comedy, beautifully written about some of the problems actors have to face".

Hough Neilson presented *I Hate Hamlet* at Wanneroo's Limelight Theatre in June 2004, "I enjoyed it so much that I decided to revisit it once more. The play itself is above all a tribute to actors".

The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee

Music and Lyrics by William Finn Book by Rachel Sheinkin Director - Kimberley Shaw

Spelling Bee, a musical comedy, centres around a fictional spelling bee set in a geographically ambiguous Putnam Valley Middle School. Six quirky adolescents compete in the Bee, run by three equally-quirky grown-ups.

Described by the New York Times as "i-r-r-e-s-i-s-t-i-b-l-e" and "o-u-t-r-a-g-e-o-u-s-l-y funny", this Tony-award winning musical follows the fortunes of six adolescents (played by adults) competing in the final stages of the Putnam County spelling competition.



As these socially-awkward over-achievers learn about winning and losing, they are supported (or not) by equally idiosyncratic grown-ups.

All the archetypes are here, from overly-tutored and hot-housed children to pushy and overly ambitious parents. When it opened on Broadway on 2005, the show earned rave reviews and won two Tony awards, including Best Book of a Musical.

Highlights from David Young - President's Speech (Outgoing) at the AGM



I have been President for 9 years – not all in a row. This last sting was four years and people say really nice things about me. Let me assure you that I really care about theatre and this club, but all the kind words really belong to so many others.

Marie Corrigan – President Elect – who is my spell checker - emailing "Have you done this?" like a nagging wife - is constant and necessary.

Natalie Arcus – "could you check these butts, I can't balance – what do I do" – she is so 'dramatic'. I have known Natalie since she was 18, I liked her then and love her now.

Bronwyn Hammond – Bronwyn and Janelle are the conscience of the club. The goodwill ambassadors!! "There's been a tsunami, floods in Burma, what is Playlovers going to do about it. I'll do it all, you don't have to do a thing!!" Bronwyn also gathers the people together for front of house. Well done!!

Kerry Goode handled publicity and I remember her saying in a time of distress about low bookings. It was just a meeting between her and I, but sometimes we feel we are the only ones that care.

Robert Vincent handled our bookings and box office again and what a great job he does, he charms his way in the heart of all those men and women - he really is a worry!

John Woolrych, our lighting designer and operator, he is the realist, the great pragmatic. If I go too far, he's the one that says no at the right time and you need that on a committee.

Kevan Hook, our bar manager that takes his responsibilities very seriously – sometimes too seriously, and in these times alcohol has to be served responsibly and I hope he continues.

Claudette Ridout – a wonderful woman who took over the secretarial position and also ran the Plover Adjudicators. Opportunity now to thank them – Claudette, Jenni Cohen, Sandra Martin and Daryl Denic.

Outside of the Committee: I want to tank Kimberley Shaw for her advise in applying for the Ignite grant... as you all know we received a \$40,000 grant, \$10,000 to improve publicity and \$30,000 for our tiered seating.

Tony Ridout – Life Member: It seems Tony has been with Playlovers forever!! Set builder, lighting/sound and everything else you can think of except for President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The loveliest man I have ever met. What has he done recently – followed up on booking tickets for ourselves, tiered seating from Acromat. We hope to have the tiered seating installed by Spelling Bee in May. Tony also organised the increase in electricity volume that comes into the building so we don't have our occasional blackouts.

Terry Tinsley – Life Member: Terry the Tenacious to me – Terry the Terrific! Since 2006 Terry set out to get the Hackett Hall for Playlovers. First of all we wrote up a rent agreement to Nedlands and they replied with rent agreement after rent agreement until we got in right between Playlovers and Nedlands. Terry has had at least 36 meetings with Nedlands, until at the last meeting on 3 January 2009, Terry announced that the Hall is ours at a



peppercorn rent. Yes we still have to obey certain rules and we have to accept the Landrover Club, Kindergarten and Life Drawing, but it will be ours from 1st May 2009. HURRAH!!!

I thank you all for four years of a wonderful time as President. Thank you. David Young

John Woolrych is no longer on the committee.


