



9 WORDS WOMEN USE

- 1. Fine: This is the word women use to end an argument when they are right and you need to shut up.
- 2. Five Minutes: If she is getting dressed, this means a half an hour. Five minutes is only five minutes if you have just been given five more minutes to watch the game before helping around the house.
- 3. Nothing: This is the calm before the storm. This means something, and you should be on your toes. Arguments that begin with nothing usually end in fine.
- 4. Go Ahead: This is a dare, not permission. Don't Do It!
- **5. Loud Sigh:** This is actually a word, but is a non-verbal statement often misunderstood by men. A loud sigh means she thinks you are an idiot and wonders why she is wasting her time standing here and arguing with you about nothing. (Refer back to #3 for the meaning of nothing.)
- **6. That's Okay:** This is one of the most dangerous statements a woman can make to a man. That's okay means she wants to think long and hard before deciding how and when you will pay for your mistake.
- 7. Thanks: A woman is thanking you, do not question, or Faint. Just say vou're welcome.
- 8. Whatever: Is a women's way of saying "F*CK YOU"!
- 9. Don't worry about it, I got it: another dangerous statement, meaning this is something that a woman has told a man to do several times, but is now doing it herself. This will later result in a man asking "What's wrong?" For the woman's response - refer to #3.

INTRODUCTION TO THEATRE LIGHTING COURSE

Playlovers are offering an 'Introduction to Theatre Lighting' course in September as they rehearse for their One Act Season.

So there is practical experience involved.

You will learn all facets of theatre lighting as part of the course.

The course will run for two 3-hour sessions and a technical rehearsal at Playlovers' normal venue which is located in **Hackett Hall, Draper Street, Floreat, WA**, on Monday 3 September and Monday 10 September from 7 to 10 pm. The tech rehearsal will be on Sunday 16 September from 3pm onwards.

Playlovers members get to do the course for free For others, the cost will be \$50.

The course will be run by Don Allen, whose recent lighting designs include Eurobeat at Playlovers, House of Frankenstein at Garrick Theatre, Seussical at Playlovers and The Playhouse, the ballet Carmen at the Quarry Amphitheatre.
