Belle is a book-loving, inventor's daughter dissatisfied with life in a small provincial French town. The Beast is a prince who because of his selfishness was placed under a spell to remain as a hideous beast unless he can gain redemption. To break the spell, he needs to learn to love another and earn love in return before the last petal from his enchanted rose falls.

One of the longest-running shows in Broadway history, "Beauty and the Beast" was nominated for nine 1994 Tony Awards including Best Musical. It's a tale as old as time, spun with magical moments and unforgettable characters like Gaston, the arrogant town Romeo; Cogsworth, the pompous clock; Lumiere, the love-struck candelabra, and the kindly teapot, Mrs. Potts. Adapted from the Academy Award-winning animated film, this production features musical favorites like the delightful "Belle", the show-stopping "Be Our Guest" and the Academy Award-winning title tune, "Beauty and the Beast".

The elaborate sets and props (pictured on page 5) have been purchased from the Melbourne production, and the lavish costumes have been hired from the same production. Playlovers will present this exciting production at the Regal Theatre opening 10th September... 4000 tickets have already been sold – so don't delay!!

THE JOB OF THE ACTOR:

I have heard it said that acting is not a creative art – it is interpretive. The actor only interprets the lines.

For years I have wrestled with this notion. Something seems wrong. True, the writer creates the play. The director conceives it and peoples it with the cast that he/she chooses. The set, costume, lighting and sound designers all have their input. They can provide the backdrop to this fairyland, and occasional stunning effect. But they do not provide the constant flow of what the audience "feels". That is the contribution of the actor. It is in creating the spark of life. There, in front of the audience, on the split second, it is the actor who must breathe life into the moment and touch the audience. By a series of thousands of such moments the actor will take the audience through the Journey of the play and bring that world to life.

I can think of no better aim than this:

THE JOB OF THE ACTOR IS TO TAKE THE DREAM OF THE WRITER AND PUT IT INTO THE HEARTS AND MINDS OF THE AUDIENCE.
